Thank you for downloading gps tracks on absolutGPS.

In recording and producing our GPS tracks we paid careful attention to the details that our users will find most helpful. On most GARMIN devices we offer you useful extra features like icons for turn, warnings for dangerous areas and points of interest. You'll find instructions on how to upload the absolutGPS routing icons to your device in Step 1 and Step 2.

The newer GARMIN models and all other GPS devices show the information in textform without routing symbols.

Step 1 Install xImage

The folder „Starterpacket/xImage/“ contains the file „xImage_23.exe“ which installs the software on your hard drive. Alternatively you can download the program from GARMIN website for free:

Step 2 Load icons on your GPS unit

Connect your GPS unit to your computer with a USB cable. Start the ximage software and follow these steps:

1. Select "Send images to the GPS" and click "OK"
2. Click "Select All" and "OK"
3. Select the folder "Starterpacket/Routingsymbole/"
4. Click "OK" and enjoy using our routing symbols
